Goddard School – Arlington Heights, IL Market Study 2018

The Goddard School is a nationally recognized child care provider franchise. The School in Arlington Heights will have the following capacity of 165 students.

The School will offer full and part time schedules. And will offer enrichment classes (art, yoga, soccer, music, etc) for the students.

The hours of operation will be approximately from 630/7am until 630/7pm, Monday through Friday. The School will be open year-round but will be closed on Federal Holidays. Occasionally through the year the school will hold staff meetings that may be after school hours. The school may also host a welcome back to school or open house event in the evening or one Saturday during the year.

The School will employ 24 new teaching and administration positions. Full & part time work schedules will be available.

The building will have several safety and security measures. Goddard requires vehicle protection where a vehicle can come within 30' of a child in the school or on the playground as indicated on our plan. A 6' fence surrounding the playgrounds and classroom exit doors is also provided and required by Goddard. Biometric scanning (fingerprint or iris scanner) is installed at the door from the lobby to the school. Along with those items, all parents are required to park and walk their child(ren) into the building and escort them to their classroom(s). The playground areas are also secured with alarmed gates and as are any classroom exit doors that are not fenced.

Goddard Systems, Inc. (GSI) conducted the following market study to review the needs for an additional child care facility in the Arlington Heights area. We utilized demographics/market analysis, and capacities of competitors and GSI determined that this location meets or exceeds all variables for approval. We did not include home daycares as they are not direct competitors, instead we looked at larger scale competitors. The franchisee who will be running the proposed Goddard School contacted the competitors for the capacity and available space in their schools.

Demographics of area:

Within 4 miles of the proposed site there are over 14,200 children under the age of 5. Of that approximately 32% is currently enrolled in child care. The average household income within that same trade area is \$97,926. That same population includes 47% that have a bachelor degree or higher.


