Mr. Recklaus:

The Arlington Heights Park District will be entering the bidding phase for basketball, pickle ball, and tennis court renovations at Dryden Park (811 E. Rockwell St.), Sunset Ridge Park (4203 N. Walnut Ave.), and Volz Park (1001 E. St. James St.). The projects are anticipated to begin in September 2021 and will include the removal and replacement of sections of path and the current basketball, pickle ball, and tennis courts. The tennis courts at Dryden Park will be replaced with six pickle ball and two tennis courts. The entry path and basketball court at Sunset Ridge Park will be replaced in their existing configuration. The pickle ball and tennis courts at Volz Park will be replaced with six pickle ball courts and the basketball court will be replaced and expanded by a few feet to improve playability.

Following prior practice, the Arlington Heights Park District respectfully requests the waiver of all applicable Village of Arlington Heights Planning and Building Permit fees and/or all applicable Village review fees. The Park Board of Commissioners and staff appreciate your assistance on this matter.
