Thank you my question is around the signage that will show on Palatine Express Road. It has to do with the light pollution during the evening hours and how disruptive this can potentially be for homeowners. (I.e will this sign light up their houses and backyards excessively at night, depending on the brightness).

Will the sign show perpendicular or parallel to Palatine Express (Parallel will shine directly towards the subdivision and specifically on houses)

- Will the sign be a bright LED (how bright) and is there any consideration on the lumens this will affect the homeowners on the other side of palatine express
- Will there be consideration for having these lights turned "off" after business has concluded / closed for the evening
- Currently there is the Floor and Décor sign (on the building) and is perpendicular to Palatine Express. I am not sure if this sign is LED, however, the brightness is not overly excessive and very reasonable. This sign is also "turned off" in the evening which is very much appreciated. This Floor and Décor sign is a fair and reasonable gauge of how the commercial light from business is managed and how it works with residential houses in the area.
