Sam,

On October 19th, 2022 at 7:30 pm, we hosted the required neighborhood meeting for property owners within 250' of the subject property to give a brief overview of the project scope and answer any questions they may have. The meeting was held in the commons at Olive-Mary Stitt Elementary School. There was (1) neighbor in attendance at the meeting. Below are the questions the attendee asked during the presentation and our initial response based on the current progress of the design. I have also included a copy of the sign-in sheet as well as the presentation that was used for the neighbors.

• Where will the building addition be located on the site?

• The building addition will primarily be located on the west side of the current facility to facilitate the necessary 4 new classrooms. The west side was chosen due to the existing Village and utility company infrastructure that currently exists on the eastern side of the building. Due to the potential economic impact of having to relocate a large quantity of existing underground utilities on the east side of the school, we have decided to implement the addition to the west side of the site.

• Will the current playground on the west side of the building be impacted?

- Yes. The current small playground on the west side will be removed as a part of this project. We are in preliminary discussions on adding additional playground equipment to the existing main playground on the east side of the site.
- Are there concerns with the proximity of the addition to Arlington Heights Rd and adjacent streets?
 - The new building addition will be setback from AH Road significantly on the west side of the site and provide adequate separation from the road and building. Our design team is reviewing if any additional protection is needed near the intersection of AH Road and Olive St.

• What is the potential impact of stormwater from the addition?

 At this time our engineer believes the existing stormwater detention facility at Olive has adequate capacity to support the newest building addition. There may be additional volume control measures that would need to be implemented such as sections or permeable pavers or other stormwater management practices to satisfy MWRD and VAH requirements that are still under consideration.

Olive-Mary Stitt Expansion

Why Now?

- Full Day Kindergarten Program
 - Need additional classrooms since currently (1) single classroom can be shared between AM section and PM section.

Increase in enrollment

- Anticipated Kindergarten enrollment bump due to transition to full day model.
- Slight General Enrollment Increase.
- Need for Small Group Space

Proposed addition will support future enrollment, full day K, provide and allow the building flexibility in their programming and support services.

Anticipated Kindergarten Enrollment Bump

- Kindergarten enrollment is currently lower than first grade enrollment due to the current ½ day kindergarten model
- Parents currently choose other Kindergarten options to provide full day learning opportunities.
- Kindergarten enrollment is expected to be more aligned with first grade enrollment once Full Day K is implemented as parents choose to send their child to their neighborhood school.

Parking and Traffic

- Main parking lot reconfigured in 2016 to improve onsite traffic flow.
- Variation to decrease the number of required onsite parking spaces from 79 to 49. *Note Olive has access to 251 parking spaces due to a license agreement with nearby church.*
 - This sharing arrangement is more efficient and allows more green space to be maintained for community use
