1. Service description.

Tots Land INC propose to open fourth location at 1007 W Euclid Ave, Arlington Heights.

We are open 7:00am-6:00pm Monday to Friday. We are closed only 8 days per year for major holidays. All together we provide childcare for 280 families. As a bilingual Polish – English program we attract families who use the opportunity for their children to learn another language. Our daily curriculum activities promote and stimulate children development in all crucial areas:

- Fine motor skills, such as drawing, writing, and painting.
- Gross motor skills, for example crawling, climbing, jumping, and running.
- Speech and language skills.
- Cognitive and intellectual skills, such as problem-solving skills, counting, identifying shapes.
- Social and emotional skills, such as playing and cooperating with other kids, controlling emotions, self-awareness.

In addition, our program is enriched in additional activities like music lessons, dance classes and acting classes where children prepare two shows every year where parents are invited.

Our centers provide a safe and nurturing environment for children. All our centers are equipped with 4K High resolution video monitoring and our DVR holds about 10 days o recording for safety. We also provide mobile application for parents where daily activities reports are created, parents receive photos and videos daily, weekly menu plans, and a monthly curriculum.

Each of our locations is equipped with a commercial kitchen where we prepare fresh and healthy food made every day from scratch. We serve three meals each day and our menu are in compliance with Illinois Board of Education Food and Nutrition Program.

2. Market Segmentation.

Tots Land INC is focused on families with children aged 15 months to 5 years who are looking for high quality childcare but yet at an affordable price. Our main customers group and middle-class families. Except of high-quality service, we also help and advise families that qualify for financial aid from the state, know as Illinois Action for Children. That allows families with lower income to afford high quality childcare.

3. Market Needs and Trends.

The childcare market is a growing sector. There are multiple factors that contribute to that trend:

- Growing number of working parents: as more families find themselves in dual-income situations, there is a grater need for child day care services as parents look for dependable care while they are at work.
- Growing understanding of importance of early childhood education: As early childhood education and development become more important, parents are enrolling their kids in childcare facilities the provide educational activities and programs.
- Urbanization and changing lifestyle: As parents look for help with childcare, the demand for child day care services is fueled by urbanization and changing lifestyles, which are defined by hectic schedules and the need for convenience.

- Women's workforce participation: The demand for daycare services is driven by the growing number of women entering the workforce and the need for dependable childcare options.
- Technological developments in childcare: The effectiveness and allure of daycare services are improved by technological advances such as electronic payment system, security features, and smartphone apps that facilitate contact between parents and daycare providers.
- Changing demographics: As a results of changing in family models, long distance between family members housing, makes grandparents or other family members unable to care for children that lead to increase in demand for daycare services.

Based on 2023 Report on Child Care in Cook County conducted by Illinois Action for Children in North and Northwest Suburban part of Cook County is 145,476 children in potential need of child care with both parents working. That includes children from birth to age 12. With total of 30,428 available slots in formal child care settings.
