We are asking for an additional 25' above the maximum 75' in the village municipal code. I hereby state that the following hardship would exist if the variance is not approved: At 75' the proposed tower would accommodate less carriers for future co-location. At 100' the monopole is more marketable to future carriers, lessening the need for said future carriers to build new facilities. At 100' feet we can get 2 additional carriers on the monopole.
