Dear Mayor Hayes,

The Arlington Heights Historical Museum is planning a new series of small ticket only events as a Museum fund raiser and Adult oriented educational program. Entitled <u>History Happy Hour</u>, these three (3) one night events will be limited to two seatings each nightwith the themed programs as followed:

June 24, 2016- 1920s Speakeasy History July 22, 2016- 1950s Cocktail Party August 26, 2016- 1970s Disco Party

Each program will include a discussion and lecture presented in historic clothing, highlighting the history of alcohol in America and Arlington Heights, and attitudes towards drinking, and liquor, and will be held at the Museum. For a pre-registered ticket the event will include sample sized "signature" drinks per person, a cash bar serving only beer, and historically appropriate hors d'oeuvres served by historically attired staff. The staffing is through a certified licensed and Bassett trained caterer specifically contracted for these events who will be handling all food and drink preparation.

Attached please find a local liquor license application from the Arlington Heights Park District; as mentioned this event will be serving the sample signature drink from each era to the participants, and era-appropriate beer only at this event. Also attached is verification of the Arlington Heights Park District's liquor and general liability coverage for the event.

We would appreciate the Village processing the local license so we may proceed to secure the State license for the events. We would also appreciate since it is a Historical Museum/Park District event that the permit fee be waived.
