TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017, FOR THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON HEIGHTS.

Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Arlington Heights that:

SECTION ONE: The sum of \$47,728,041, being the aggregate of appropriations (including debt service) for the year beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017 as appropriated for said calendar year by the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the Village of Arlington Heights, duly passed by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Arlington Heights, and approved on the 5th day of December, 2016, for such purposes as: Police and Fire Protection, Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF), Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA), Police Pension Fund, Firefighters Pension Fund, Capital Improvement, Memorial Library Fund, and General Debt Service Fund, less the estimated revenue from sources other than general taxation, be, and the same is hereby levied on all property within the corporate limits of the Village of Arlington Heights, subject to taxation for the current fiscal year. The said appropriations, estimates of revenue from sources other than general taxation, and amounts to be raised by general taxation are as follows:
